Essential Technical & Financial Qualifying Criteria:-

FOR WORKS CONTRACTS

1. The Agency / Firms /Contractor must have earlier experience in execution of similar nature of conservation works attended at ancient temples, heritage sites etc. Tender invited should be as per **Central Vigilance Commission's** guidelines as detailed below.
 - i) Average annual financial turn over during the last three years, ending 31st March of previous financial year should be at least 30 % of the estimated cost.
 - ii) Experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending last days of month previous to the one in which the applications are invited should be either of the following:-
 - a) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40 % of the estimated amount.

or
 - b) Two similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 50 % of the estimated cost.

or
 - c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.

FOR STORE/PURCHASE CONTRACTS
