- Tenders must be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit of Rs.5,40,700/- (2 % of the tender cost) which should be paid by Demand Draft favoring “Superintending archaeologist, Bhubaneswar Circle” payable at Bhubaneswar at the time of submission of bids along with the Technical Bid.

- The Technical Bid only shall be opened at **15:30** hours on the same day in the presence of the Bidders or their authorized representatives intending to attend the opening of bid.
- The Financial Bid will be opened after scrutinizing the Technical Bid and the date and time will be intimated in due course to the bidders who will qualified in the Technical Bid.

- Details of scope of the work, essential technical & financial qualifying criteria of Agencies / Firms, term and conditions etc. are also available in the above website.
- Any Bid received without Earnest Money on the form as specified in Bid documents & incomplete bid shall not be considered and shall be summarily rejected.
- ASI reserves the right to cancel the Bids before submission/opening of Bids, postpone the Bid submission/opening date and to accept/reject any or all Bids without assigning any reasons thereof. ASI's assessment of suitability as per eligibility criteria shall be final and binding.
- Bidders may note that they are liable to be disqualified at any time during Bid process in case any of the information furnished by them is not found to be true. EMD of such Bidder shall be forfeited. The decision of ASI in this regard shall be final and binding.
- The transfer of Bid documents purchased by one intending Bidders to another Bidder is not permissible. Bidders can submit Bids only on the documents purchased from ASI.
- The specifications of all the materials to be used should be got approved from the Engineer-In-Charge before start of work..
- **Time Period:-** 02 (Two) Years.
- Eligibility of the bidders shall be assessed based on the “**Essential Qualifying Criteria**” as given in Annexure-A.

Essential Technical & Financial Qualifying Criteria:-

1. The Agency / Firms /Contractor must have earlier experience in execution of similar nature of conservation works attended at ancient temples, monuments, old heritage structures sites etc. in **Archaeological Survey of India**.
Tender invited as per **Central Vigilance Commission's** guidelines as detailed below.
 - i) Average annual financial turn over during the last three years, ending 31st March of previous financial year should be at least 30 % of the estimated cost.
 - ii) Experience of having successfully completed similar works of conservation of old monuments/sites in **Archaeological Survey of India** during last 7 years ending last days of month previous to the one in which the applications are invited should be either of the following:-
 - a) Three similar completed works of conservation of old monuments/sites of **Archaeological Survey of India** costing not less than the amount equal to 40 % of the estimated amount.
or
 - b) Two similar completed work of conservation of old monuments/sites of **Archaeological Survey of India** costing not less than the amount equal to 50 % of the estimated cost.
or
 - c) One similar completed work of conservation of old monuments/sites of **Archaeological Survey of India** as above costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.
 - ii) Prequalification / Post Qualification shall be based entirely upon the capability and resources of prospective bidders to perform the particular contract satisfactorily, taking into account their (i) experience and post performance on similar contracts as mentioned above for last two years (ii) experience specially in lime mortar masonry, pointing and lime concrete etc. (iii) financial standing through latest I.T.C.C, Annual report (balance sheet and profit & loss account) of last three years.
2. The Agency /Firms / Contractors etc. must have necessary infrastructure and Tools & Plants, Machinery, Equipments, technical personnel, supervisors, skilled labourers etc. for execution of the tender work.

Before commencing of works, it shall be obligatory for the Agency / Firm to obtain at his own cost, insurance cover from reputed companies for following requirements.

Note: Bidder should submit authenticated proof of turnover amount and experience as indicated above failing which the Bid will be summarily rejected.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. Preparation and Submission of Tender: The tender should be submitted in two parts i.e. **Technical Bid** and **Price Bid**. The Technical Bid and the Price Bid should be sealed by the bidder in two separate covers "Price Bid super-scribed with tender number" and "Price Bid super-scribed with tender number ". Both Sealed Envelopes should be kept in a main/ bigger envelope super-scribed as with "**TENDER NUMBER**". Tender not adhering to this condition will be rejected.
2. The Price Bids (Annexure II) of bidders who have qualified in the Technical Bid (Cover I – Annexure I-only will be opened and the rest will be rejected.
3. Earnest Money Deposit: The bidder shall be required to submit refundable amount of **Rs.5,40,700/- (Rupees Five lakh Forty thousand Seven hundred only)** as Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) by way of demand drafts only. The demand drafts shall be drawn in favour of "Superintending Archaeologist, Bhubaneswar Circle" payable at Bhubaneswar.

The demand drafts for earnest money deposit must be enclosed in the envelope containing the **COVER I (Technical bid)**. The EMD of the successful bidder shall be returned after the successful Completion of contract / order and for unsuccessful bidder(s) it would be returned after award of the contract. Bid(s) received without demand draft of EMD / Tender Fees will be rejected.

4. Currency: Rate should be quoted in Indian Rupees (INR) including transportation, loading unloading and all taxes etc.
5. Validity: The rates quoted by the bidder must be valid till the completion of work from the date of the bid. The overall offer for the assignment and bidder(s) quoted price shall remain unchanged during the period of validity. If the bidder quoted the validity shorter than the required period, the same will be treated as unresponsive and it will be rejected. In case the bidder withdraws, modifies or changes their offer during the validity period, bid is liable to be rejected and the earnest money deposit shall be forfeited without assigning any reason thereof. The bidder should also be ready to extend the validity, if required, without changing any terms, conditions etc. of their original tender.
6. Payment Term: To be made according to the completion of work, being verified by the Gazetted Officer/Engineering Officer of Archaeological Survey of India.
7. The Superintending Archaeologist, Archaeological Survey of India, Bhubaneswar Circle reserves the right to accept in part or in full or reject any or more quotation/Tender(s) without assigning any reasons or cancel the tendering process or and reject all quotations at any time prior to award of contract, without incurring any liability, whatsoever to the affected bidder or bidder(s).
8. Machinery and Equipments brought to the site by the Agency at their own risk.
9. Contract may terminate at any time without any prior notice if service of bidder not found Satisfactory.

1. The bidders are subject to be disqualified if they have:

- a) Made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements: and/ or
- b) Record of poor performance such as abandoning the works, not properly completing the contract, inordinate delays in completion, litigation history, or financial failures etc.: and or
- c) Participated in the previous bidding for the same work and had quoted unreasonable prices and could not furnish rational justification to the Engineer-in-charge.
- d) Indulged in unlawful & corrupt means in obtaining bids.
- e) Been black listed/their registrations by the competent authority.

2. The following item of work which should be attended in archaeological principle and manner:
 - a) In any circumstances the nature and character of the structure will not be changed. It must be done as per original.
 - b) Surface dressing of the ground.
 - c) Earth excavation in stone mixed earth, slush and gravel to expose the original existing wall.
 - d) Filling in plinth.
 - e) Providing & laying cement concrete.
 - f) Providing of renovation of laterite stone masonry in lime mortar including taking out damaged laterite stone with providing new laterite stone after cutting, fine dressing, lime joint and finishing as per the original texture in foundation and super structure.
 - g) Providing recess pointing to joints including cleaning of joints with combination lime mortar (1:1:1) lime paste 1:surkhi 1: sand 1 with other binding materials mixed with stone dust and matching with original
 - h) Stones to be used as per specification matching with original
3. Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The Bidder shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work. Submission of a bid by a bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates.
4. The bidders, in preparing the bid, shall rely on site investigation reports referred to in the Contract Data, supplemented by any information available to the bidder.
5. The bidder is expected to examine carefully all instructions, conditions of contract as per terms and conditions etc.
6. All the work will be supervised by the site in-charge and also inspected by team of officers of ASI as and when required. The contractor is liable to answer all the queries.
7. The contractor shall bear cost of various incidentals, sundries and contingencies necessitated by work e.g. Rent, Royalties, Cess and other charges of materials, Octroi and all other taxes including prevailing Sales Tax/VAT, EPF/ESI from time to time. Ferry tolls, conveyance charges and other cost including temporary building required by the tenderer for collection of materials, storage, housing of staff or other purpose of the work are to be borne by the contractor at his own cost. No rent will be payable to Govt. for temporary occupation of land owned by the Authority at the site of the work for bonafide use of the land for work and all such construction of temporary nature by the contractor shall be done after obtaining written permission from the Authority and all such construction shall have to be demolished and debris removed and ground made cleared after completion of the work at no extra cost.
8. The contractor shall furnish a certificate along with the tender to the effect that he is not related to any officer in the rank of an Assistant Engineer and above in Archaeological Survey of India. If the fact subsequently proved to be false, the contract is liable to be rescinded. The EMD and total Security Money will be forfeited and he shall be liable to make good the loss or damages resulting from such cancellation.
9. The tenderer shall have to abide by the Archaeological Works Code and CPWD Safety code rules
10. The contractor has to arrange the samples of materials required for execution to be got tested and approved by the Department Engineer before taking up the work and during course of execution required from time to time.

11. If there is any damage to the work due to natural calamities like due to natural calamities like flood or cyclone or any other cause during the course of execution of work or up to 6 months after completion of work or if any, imperfection, becomes apparent to the work within 6 months from the date of final certificate of completion of work the contractor shall make good of all such damages at his own cost with no extra cost to the Department
12. All materials before they are being used in the items of works as per this schedule of quantities and also the finished items of work where tests are applicable shall have to be tested through the Engineer/site in-charge
13. Schedule of quantities is accompanied, it shall be definitely understood that the ASI does not accept any responsibility for the correctness or completeness of this schedule and that this schedule is liable for alternation or omissions, deductions, additions or alternations shall no way invalidate the contract and no extra monetary compensation will be entertained
14. The department will have the right to supply at any time in the interest of work any departmental materials to be used in the work and the contractor shall use such materials without any controversy or dispute on that account. The rate of issued of such materials will be at the stock issue rates inclusive of storage charges or rates fixed by the Department or current market rate whichever is higher.
15. Any defects, shrinkage or other faults which may be noticed within 12 months from the completion of the work arising out of defective or improper materials or workmanship timing are upon the direction of the engineer-in-charge to be amended and made good by the contractor at his own cost unless the engineer for reasons to be recorded in writing shall be decided that they ought to be paid for and in case of default Department may recover from the contractor the cost of making good the works.
16. From the commencement of the works to the completion of the same, they are to be under the contractor's charges. The contractor is to be held responsible to make good all injuries, damages and repairs occasioned or rendered necessary the same by fire or other cause and they hold the Govt. of India harmless for any claims for injuries to person or structural damage to property happening for any neglect, default, want of proper care or misconduct on the part of the contractor or any one in his employment during the execution of the work. Also no claim shall be entertained for loss due to earthquake, flood, cyclone, epidemic, riot or any other calamity whether natural or incidental damages so caused will have to be made good by the contractor at his own cost.
17. Where it will be found necessary by the Deptt., the site-in-charge of the work shall issue an order book to the contractor to be kept at the site of the work with pages serially numbered. Orders regarding the work whenever necessary are to be entered in this book by the ASI officer-in-charge with their dated signatures and duly noted by the contractor or his authorized agents with their dated signatures. Orders entered in this book and noted by the contractor's agent shall be considered to have been duly given to the contractor following the instructions of the Deptt. The order book shall be the property of the ASI and shall not be removed from the site of work without written permission of the authority and to be submitted to the site-in-charge every month.
18. All the works will be supervised by the site in-charge and also inspected by team of officers of ASI/CMC as and when required. The contractor is liable to answer all the queries
19. The contractor shall conform in all respects, by giving all notices and paying all fees, with the provisions of the rules and regulations of all public bodies and companies whose property right are affected or may be affected in any way by the works.
20. Payment of bill part or full be made through check measurement by the Engineer/Officer of Archeological Survey of India.
